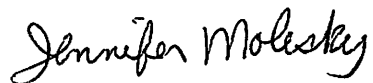
Christine Barton from the Express Newspaper passed on information from the First Presbyterian Church in Schaghticoke that they will be opening a satellite food pantry in March.
