Shawn Hayes said he would contact the State and County Highway Departments.

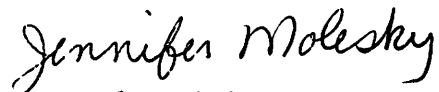
Firemen from the town commented on the Ambulance District.
