Resident from Meadowview Drive walks on his road and commented on the litter and tires along the road.

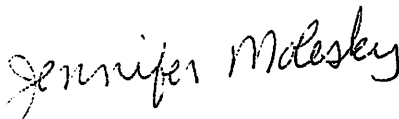
Tom Ryan discussed rescue squad and suggested calling the county for the dispatch numbers.
