Supervisor Salisbury opened PUBLIC HEARING ON THE MS4 REPORT at 6:51

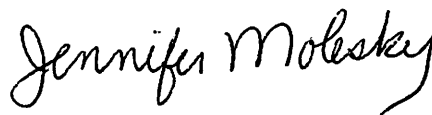
